Contact Donalsonville Fire Rescue (229-524-2117) and request a burn permit

Burn Permits do not cost any money

Burning without a permit may result in a fine.

You Can Burn

- √ Any Natural Vegetation including: Sticks and Limbs, Grass Clippings, Pine straw, Leaves, Hay, Weeds, Garden Plots
- $\sqrt{}$ Inside of a purpose built burn ring, pit, cage, etc.

You Cannot Burn

- **X** Manmade materials including: Plastics, Treated or Painted Lumber, Textiles, Furniture, etc.
- **X** Trash or Debris containing manmade materials
- X Household garbage
- **X** Any Flammable Liquids including: Any Gasoline, Diesel, Fuels, Oils, etc.
- X Cannot Burn inside of a 55-gallon drum.

You are Responsible for the following at the time of permit approval:

- $\sqrt{}$ Have access to a way to extinguish the fire. (water hose, fire extinguisher, etc.)
- $\sqrt{}$ All fires for disposal of vegetation are to be out at sunset the day the permit is issued.

Special Considerations

- Grilling or a fire for cooking does not require a permit.
- Permits are issued according to weather conditions on a day to day basis.
- State Enacted Burn Bans by Georgia Forestry may restrict burn regulations further.
